

**Welcome to Trinity School 6<sup>th</sup> Form Conference:** an annual event that we hope you will enjoy, be challenged and grow from. The Conference theme is rooted in exploring our 'Inner being and Outer person' based on Psalm 139. You will have opportunities for quiet reflection and sharing of experience and participation in collective creative forms. Please refer to the back of the program to find out which group and workshop you have been allocated.

**Group One:** Art Workshop in the **Hall** with Andrew Norwood leading a collective creation of floor art, giving you time to reflect and express on your inner being and outer person.

**Group Two:** Drama Workshop in the **Studio** with John Harley and James Huntington leading a morning of creative activities inspired by drama therapy exercises: Students will have opportunities to explore their philosophy and outlook on life through drama games and improvisation. Through self-expression and fun we will learn insights into ourselves and what we value in life.

**Group Three:** Gospel Singing Workshop in **Chapel** with Fiona Bolton leading a morning of singing: a time to express yourself through music, embracing the inner person within the collective experience of singing.

**Group Four:** Psalm Drummers Workshop in the **Study Room** with Dan Abbotts and Terl Bryant leading a morning on 'Using drums to discover the Psalms'. They will be bringing 35 drums and together you will create a rhythmic beat of music.
